Annual fundraising events are critical in the annual operating budget for All Angels. Our goal is to maintain a high quality program at affordable rates with small class sizes and low teacher to student ratios. We rely on fundraising to supply over 5% of our annual operating budget. All money earned once operating costs are covered is utilized by the school to fund a weekly music program, continuing education for teachers, and other program enrichments and enhancements. While the Board of Directors typically leads the way on these fundraising events and tries to keep them to a minimum, parent input, support and help is expected and needed to make everything run smoothly. Please check below any and all events you may be willing to help with.

___ Bake sales are usually held in the fall, but may be held in the spring as well and involve baking, preparing and selling.
___ Our Fall Event is usually held in September/October and may be a pizza sale, flower bulb sale, or other activity as determined.
___ The Silent Auction is our big event and is a lot of fun. It involves a lot of coordination for donations, food, set-up, clean-up, selling, and more. It is typically held the first weekend of December.
___ Our spring event(s) vary. We may have a bake sale and another small event, or we may have just one big event. Sometimes we have a pizza sale, summer flower bulb sales, or a rummage sale. The time frame is from late February through May, depending on the choices made.

Two events are for community building but still require parent help and support.

___ Mardi Gras Carnival is held right before Ash Wednesday and involves kids games and prizes, food and fun
___ Fall Open House and Family Night is usually held in late August or early September. It involves planning and organizing, setting up and cleaning up.

Another option for parent volunteers is to serve on our **Parent Phone Tree**. We need six or seven parents who are willing to make six or seven phone calls to other parents when we have a school function. We provide the list of names, the scripts for the calls, just need help to make them.
